? What are the results?

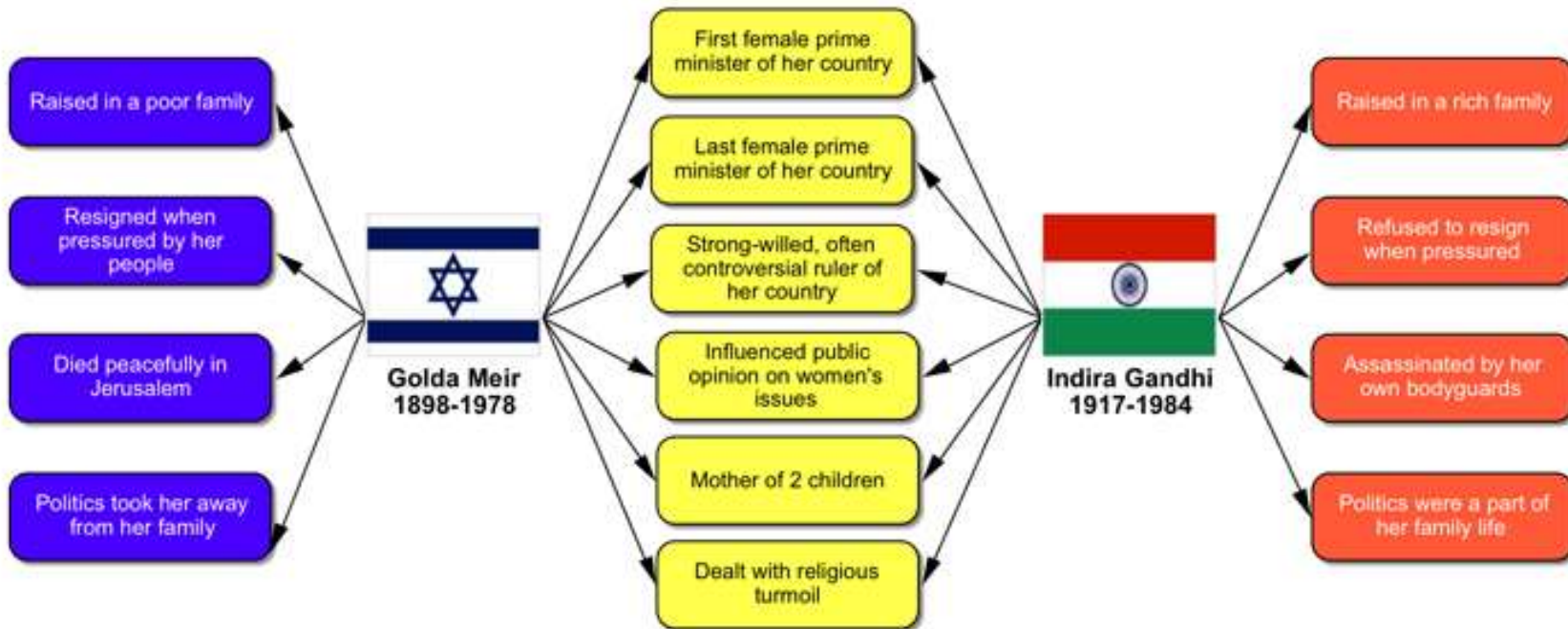
- 1 Sour fruits have more electricity ⇒ More acid

The Need to Accept the Coexistence of Good and Evil: The Most Important Theme in "To Kill a Mockingbird"

Working Thesis Statement

The most important theme in "To Kill a Mockingbird" is that survival depends upon a mature understanding of people: that they are both good and evil.

Introduction

Hook: Start with interesting quote that brings in thesis, such as Atticus telling Jem: "There's a lot of ugly things in this world, son. I wish I could keep em all away from you. That's never possible." Explain the quote and finish intro with thesis statement.

Argument / Main Idea 1

Tom Robinson, Boo Radley, and Jem suffer consequences for innocence

Tom falsely accused and killed

Boo locked away in house; almost has to go on trial which might have destroyed him

Jem attacked by Bob Ewell

Argument / Main Idea 2

Atticus remains strong despite injustices against him and others

Sees evil (Tom falsely accused) but fights it in court

Walks away when Ewell spits in face

Defeated in court, but walks out with head high and committed to fight on

Argument / Main Idea 3

Scout learns to see the world as it is: with evil, but also goodness and love

Boo feared at first, but she learns that he is innocent...

Sees evil such as racism, but also Atticus love and courage

She grows strong that summer to see the world as it is

Conclusion

Review injustices against the innocent; strength of Atticus; wisdom and goodness of sheriff despite his flaws and mistakes; growth in Scout; her understanding of the coexistence of good and evil has helped her to survive all these years as she looks back.
